A focus on the sources also helps to modify the view that his music progressed steadily in the direction of the twelve-tone technique. The works reveal instead a concern with expressing the essence of the text, this lyricism rather than articulating a substantially different aesthetic from the later works. This provides a better understanding of the consummate lyricism of all his music, however compressed or fragmented its utterance in the classic twelve-tone works.
