

# The Soviet Legacy

On July 13, 1944 the Soviet troops entered and occupied Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania. The rest of the country fell in a matter of a few days. The small Baltic state remained in oppression for the next five decades.

Its citizens lived through horrors difficult to even think about. They had jobs but many companies were inefficient. They could not always buy enough food for their families. Their religion was suppressed and the local language forbidden. And worst of all, their friends, family members and neighbours could be shipped to labour camps in Siberia without any notice, never to return.

Lithuania was not the only country to go through this. The Soviets took control of 15 countries by force at the end of the Second World War. Its government influenced the lives of nearly 291 million people.

It has now been 30 years since the collapse of the Union. So how are the former USSR countries doing today? Even though they have made economic and social progress, the legacy from the years of oppression is still present. In this visualisation, we explore how these countries compare to the rest of the world in terms of mental health, politics and economy.
