## DEFINITION


Predictive validity evaluates the capability of a measurement or assessment to foretell future occurrences or results. It's a subtype of criterion validity, focusing specifically on future outcomes. When an instrument, like a test or survey, demonstrates a strong correlation between its results and future happenings, it is said to have high predictive validity.

## TYPES

- **SAT Scores:** The extent to which SAT scores can forecast a student's future academic performance in college demonstrates its predictive validity.
- **Job Assessment Tests:** When a pre-employment test accurately predicts an applicant's future job performance, it exemplifies its predictive validity.
