His approach is to separate the major drivers and motivations and consider the ways each has contributed to organized conflict. They range from the impulses embedded in human biology and psychology to the incentives to conflict developed through cultural evolution to competition for resources, conflicts stirred by the passions of belief, the effects of ecological stresses, the drive for power in leaders and nations, and the search for security. The discussions show remarkable range, delving deep into the Neolithic past through the twentieth-century world wars and up to the current conflict in Ukraine.
