This study investigated the implementation and outcomes of blended learning that integrated Apagea Math, an online intelligent tutor system (ITS) with face-to-face instruction for the teaching and learning of Algebra 1. It took place in a Title I urban high school where 75 ninth-grade students and their teachers enacted the blended learning program for one semester. Students from the same high school who received face-to-face instruction alone during a previous semester served as a comparison group. Flow theory was proposed as an explanation for why the ITS program was expected to increase student engagement and improve student achievement. This quasi-experimental, mixed-methods study collected data via student assessments, surveys, observation forms, questionnaires, and meeting notes. Fidelity of implementation was rated based on four components: adherence, exposure, quality of delivery, and participant responsiveness. Challenges encountered and practices used when implementing the program were characterized as first-order external or second-order internal and were analyzed to reveal themes. A mixed ANOVA conducted on assessment data revealed a significant interaction effect between time (pre or post) and group (intervention or comparison) on achievement,  $F(1, 157) = 5.25, p < .05$ .
