Reading Hitler's Mind Norman Ridley, 2022-07-20 Most strongly associated with Prime Minister Neville Chamberlain it is often stated that Britain's policy of appeasement was instituted in the 1930s in the hope of avoiding war with Hitler's Nazi Germany At the time appeasement was viewed by many as a popular and seemingly pragmatic policy In this book the author sets out to show how appeasement was not a naive attempt to secure a lasting peace by resolving German grievances but a
