Gaff,2025-05 If there was a first face of baseball it was arguably Christopher Christy Mathewson At the opening of the twentieth century baseball was considered an undignified game played by ruffians for gamblers benefit Mathewson changed all that When he signed with the Giants in 1900 his contract stated he wouldn t pitch on Sundays and he was known for his honesty integrity and good looks In his first fourteen seasons as a pitcher for the Giants Mathewson never won fewer than twenty games in a season and he almost single handedly won the 1905 World Series In 1918 though age thirty eight and exempt from military service he enlisted for World War I where he exposed himself to nearly lethal amounts of mustard gas as he taught soldiers how to put on gas masks When he returned home he was diagnosed with lung problems and tuberculosis which led to his untimely death at the age of forty five After Mathewson s death his eulogies were many but it was impossible to catch the essence of his life in a single newspaper column Jane Mathewson his widow was determined to provide the reading public with a more intimate portrait of her husband and approached prominent sportswriter Bozeman Bulger who had known Mathewson for twenty years Bulger wrote a series of articles titled *The Life Story of Christy Mathewson* His portraits about the player were amplified by original accounts from Jane and several unpublished chapters from Mathewson himself which had been discovered among his papers These combined accounts allow readers to hear from Mathewson and those who knew him best A superstar long before that term was coined Mathewson became an icon of sportsmanship He was posthumously elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame at its
