Moreover high quantities of low quality food e.g from human sources do not compensate for the urban birds dietary deficiency and may instead lead to reduced capacity to mount physiological responses to deal with air pollutants or infections

3 children's relation to nature attitude and knowledge is not impacted by urbanization but predicted instead by socioeconomic factors and the quality of nature close to their homes These local differences call for more detailed approaches when studying cities since both social and environmental variation within urban areas can be more consequential than general divides In this thesis I demonstrate the importance of native vegetation in cities and food quality for urban animals Local wildlife influences people and by better understanding the urban ecosystem we are one step closer to building cities that will allow future generations to learn about species and enjoy nature near their homes
