



sources he develops a wide ranging account of violence in modern French politics In so doing he provides powerful insights into political violence scapegoating the idea of sacrifice and the widespread French obsession with conspiracy Burton demonstrates that time and again the same basic scenario has been acted out on the streets of Paris one or more people would be singled out from the community and imprisoned exiled or more often subjected to violence by the crowd or the state In particular he explores how Catholicism in its extreme ultrareactionary form shaped the worldviews of Parisians and how the killing of a sacrificial victim came to be seen as a reenactment of the crucifixion of Christ
