Five key characteristics of the opera are the overture, spectacle and pageantry, voice externalization and the interaction between the lead singers and the chorus. These features are used to describe Italy and its cultural mindset. Thus, the metaphor is a guide or map that helps such outsiders as students, travelers and managers on short-term and long-term assignments understand quickly what members of a culture consider important.
