approaches when studying cities since both social and environmental variation within urban areas can be more consequential than general divides In this thesis I demonstrate the importance of native vegetation in cities and food quality for urban animals Local wildlife influences people and by better understanding the urban ecosystem we are one step closer to building cities that will allow future generations to learn about species and enjoy nature near their homes Urban Ecosystems Frederick R.
