basically chronological while Matthew tends to group material topically leading the writers to build their harmonies around either Mark or Luke Robertson succeeds more than most in retaining the sequence of all three narratives other than Matthew and thus I have chosen to use his work as the foundation for this book Another issue that arises when studying the life of Christ as recorded in the Gospels is the problem of matching it with what we know about the history of the Roman Empire at the time of Jesus Luke gives more chronological markers than the other Gospel writers but the range of times associated with the rulers he mentions still leaves quite a bit of room for controversy The dating scheme I have chosen to follow has Jesus being born around 6 BC beginning His public ministry in 29 AD and going to the Cross during the Passover in 33 AD
