the son of grocery store owners but after he was unable to get a job in the family business he started his own brokerage firm While Howard ran his investment business he also served on the Omaha Board of Education for four years and then ran for the US House of Representatives He was elected and relocated the family to Washington DC There Warren attended public schools and graduated from Woodrow Wilson High in 1947 five years later He was only seventeen years old [My Warren Buffett Bible](#) Robert L.
