- Engineering:
  - Is a risky activity which has the potential to present some danger!
  - Can be regarded as an experiment not conducted under lab controls
  - Is based on uncertainties and assumptions with unknown outcomes
- Must learn from past mistakes and monitor over long periods of time
- If possible, safe exits **MUST** be provided when human life is at risk
- Public **MUST** be informed of any risk → respect for life
