M. Montgomery who responded to Jane Eyre as part of the Cinderella tradition Heiniger contrasts the reactions of these white women writers with that of Hannah Crafts whose *Jane Eyre* influenced *The Bondswoman's Narrative* rejects the Cinderella model Instead Heiniger shows Crafts creates a heroic female bildungsroman that critiques fairytale narratives from the viewpoint of the obscure oppressed workers who remain forever outside the tales of wonder produced for middle class consumption Heiniger concludes by demonstrating how Brontë's middle class American readers projected the self-rise ethic onto Jane Eyre mirroring the novel in nineteenth-century narratives of American identity formation
