

WASHINGTON — President Nixon resigned last night, saying he did so to heal the wounds of Watergate and to give America "a full-time president" in Gerald R. Ford.

Nixon urged Americans to rally behind Ford, who will assume the powers of the presidency at noon today, the effective hour of Nixon's resignation.

Nixon said he would have preferred to fight the virtually certain impeachment that awaited him in Congress, "to market the personal agency that would have been involved."

But he said the interests of the nation demanded that he step down, to end the dimensions of scandal that presaged the White House and the impeachment process that kept Congress from other duties.

"America needs a full-time president and a full-time Congress, particularly at this time with the problems we face at home and abroad," Nixon said.


Ford watched an interview at his suburban Alexandria, Va., home, then stepped outside and pledged his best efforts for "what's good for America and what's good for the world."

Ford announced that Henry A. Kissinger will remain as secretary of state (Page 2) and said that he hoped they will work "in the pursuit of peace as we have achieved in the past."

Nixon had said he hopes world peace will be a lasting monument to his 24 years in the White House. And Ford said Nixon "made one of the great personal sacrifices for the country and one of the finest
