sandstone I can find them in the records know for sure who they are Primus s stone is harder to know The tradition here on the farm is that Primus the foreman at Upper Bremono is buried here but I cannot be sure The stone reads Prams 12 and I m not sure that it refers to this Primus It may be his grandson also Primus or some person I don t know yet It s the 12 that throws me the Primus I know lived to be an old man long past 1812 his death date is noted 1849 That date seems right according to the records but then the records are so sparse it s hard to know I don t know how to solidify to give storied flesh to these rough marks hewn deep into stone
