## SURFACE WEB

The portion of the World Wide Web that is indexed by search engines. It can be viewed by general users on standard Web browsers.

## DEEP WEB

This part of the Web extends beyond the reach of typical search engines because it includes unindexed sites, fee-for-service (FFS) content, and private databases such as password-protected e-mail accounts. The deep web comprises the overwhelming majority of online content.

## DARK WEB

An encrypted network that can be accessed only with a specialized browser or application. The most common method of interacting with the dark web is through The Onion Router (Tor), an anonymizing platform that routes encrypted traffic through a series of nodes. Criminal and antisocial behaviour appear to account for the majority of dark web activity.
