

The Great Chalk Way



The Great Chalk Way is a re-creation of what is thought to be England's oldest coast-to-coast route, which follows a ridge of chalk from Lyme Regis on Dorset's Jurassic Coast to the Wash in Norfolk.

It was the safest way of travelling in Medieval times, avoiding the impenetrable forests in the valleys below, and is today a combination of footpaths, bridleways, byways and the occasional road. It is packed with historic sites, such as Avebury's stone circles and the Uffington White Horse, and provides breathtaking views.

It comprises four existing long-distance paths - the Wessex Ridgeway, the Ridgeway National Trail, the Icknield Way Path and the Peddars Way National Trail - and the more recently established Sarnen Trail, which incorporates the Cranborne Drovers Way.

It is a family of long-distance paths, with each component path retaining its own identity and waymarks. The route shown is for walkers only, but routes for cyclists and equestrians are also available.
