Salem the Berkshires then to The Wayside in Concord The Scarlet Letter was published in 1850 followed by a succession of other novels A political appointment as consul took Hawthorne and family to Europe before their return to Concord in 1860 Hawthorne died on May 19 1864 and was survived by his wife and their three children Much of Hawthorne s writing centers on New England many works featuring moral metaphors with an anti Puritan inspiration His fiction works are considered part of the Romantic movement and more specifically dark romanticism His themes often center on the inherent evil and sin of humanity and his works often have moral messages and deep psychological complexity His published works include novels short stories and a biography of his college friend Franklin Pierce the 14th President of the United States In 1836 Hawthorne served as the editor of the American Magazine of Useful and Entertaining Knowledge
