Alone, you are almost safe. With her keen ear and attentive eye, Dorianne Laux offers us a universe with which we are familiar but gives it to us fresh. Dorianne Laux is the author of two previous collections of poetry from BOA Editions Ltd and is co-author with Kim Addonizio of *The Poet's Companion: A Guide to the Joys of Writing Poetry* (W. W. Norton, 1997), chosen as an alternate selection by several bookclubs. Laux was the judge for the 2012 A. Poulin Jr. Poetry Contest and is a tenured professor in the creative writing program at the University of Oregon. Laux lives in Eugene, Oregon.
