

In defending this argument, he claims that it presupposes the theory of time commonly referred to as the A theory of time, which is roughly the view that time really does flow from the nonexistent future into the present and then out of existence into the past. Though this may be the

commonsense view of time it is not the view held by many philosophers and physicists Because Craig s argument relies on a controversial view of time the argument in my view carries an unnecessary burden of proof on behalf of the A theory My thesis then is to argue in support of the kalam cosmological argument but also to argue against Craig s claim that it must be dependent on the A theory of time the result of which will be a more general yet stronger version of the kalam cosmological argument for the existence of God
