fail to take sufficient account of the impact of social practical and environmental factors such as housing and access to public transport on disabled people's ability to participate in society and the additional costs they therefore incur The Committee believes that the Government should listen to the views of disabled people and their representative organisations and conduct a further trial before the criteria are adopted and the new assessment is introduced Once the initial assessments for PIP have been completed in the first geographical area the Government should look again at the value of face to face assessments for PIP claims where claimants conditions are severe and unlikely to change It is also important that DWP gets the contracting process with the private suppliers right
