

Author Henry David Thoreau July 12 1817 May 6 1862 was an American essayist poet philosopher abolitionist naturalist tax resister development critic surveyor and historian A leading transcendentalist Thoreau is best known for his book *Walden* a reflection upon simple living in natural surroundings and his essay *Civil Disobedience* originally published as *Resistance to Civil Government* an argument for disobedience to an unjust state Thoreau's books articles essays journals and poetry amount to more than 20 volumes Among his lasting contributions are his writings on natural history and philosophy in which he anticipated the methods and findings of ecology and environmental history two sources of modern day environmentalism His literary style interweaves close observation of nature personal experience pointed rhetoric symbolic meanings and historical lore while displaying a poetic sensibility philosophical austerity and Yankee attention to practical detail He was also deeply interested in the idea of survival in the face of hostile elements historical change and natural decay at the same time he advocated abandoning waste and illusion in order to discover life's true essential needs He was a lifelong abolitionist delivering lectures that attacked the Fugitive Slave Law while praising the writings of Wendell Phillips and defending the abolitionist John Brown Thoreau's philosophy of civil disobedience later influenced the political thoughts and actions of such notable figures as Leo Tolstoy Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King Jr Thoreau is sometimes referred to
