

Finally I introduce the transcription factor SP5 which I discovered is an important target of Wnt signaling in hPSCs and hNSCs In Chapter 2 I describe high throughput RNA sequencing expression analysis of Wnt3a treated hPSCs I identify SP5 as a key transcriptional target and characterize its binding genome wide by chromatin immunoprecipitation followed by sequencing I demonstrate that SP5 functions by repressing Wnt antagonist genes and that this activity restricts the formation of definitive endoderm in Wnt treated hPSCs In Chapter 3 I describe the effects of Wnt pathway activation on pluripotency and differentiation to early germ layers I further discuss the novel role of Wnt signaling as a negative regulator of EGR1 expression In Chapter 4 I demonstrate the effects of Wnt signaling on hNSC multipotency and differentiation I describe high throughput RNA sequencing expression analysis of Wnt3a treated hNSCs I identify FGF family members and SP5 as key transcriptional targets and demonstrate their roles promoting hNSC multipotency and proliferation In Chapter 5 I discuss the broader implications of my findings and speculate on the subject and results of future work in the field
