

VOCABULARIO GEOLOGICO

1. **NUCLEO.-** Zona más interna de la Tierra, se extiende desde la discontinuidad de Gutenberg hasta el centro de la Tierra. Formado principalmente por Fe y Ni. Núcleo externo (líquido) y núcleo interno (sólido), separados por la discontinuidad de Wiechert-Lehman.
2. **MANTO .-** El manto terrestre es la capa de la Tierra que se encuentra directamente debajo de la corteza, prolongándose en profundidad hasta el límite exterior del núcleo (ocupa aproximadamente el 87% de la tierra).
3. **CORDILLERA.-** Una cordillera es una sucesión de montañas enlazadas entre sí (mayor que la sierra). Constituyen zonas plegadas o en fase de plegamiento. En los geosinclinales, zonas alargadas situadas en los bordes de los continentes, se acumula un gran espesor de sedimentos.
4. **ISOSTASIA.-** La isostasia es la condición de equilibrio que presenta la superficie terrestre debido a la diferencia de densidad de sus partes. Se resuelve en movimientos verticales (epirogénicos) y está fundamentada en el principio de Arquímedes. Fue enunciada como principio a finales del siglo XIX.
5. **DERIVA CONTINENTAL.-** La deriva continental es el desplazamiento de las masas continentales unas respecto a otras. Esta hipótesis fue desarrollada en 1912 por el alemán Alfred Wegener a partir de diversas observaciones empíricas, pero no fue hasta los años 60, con el desarrollo de la tectónica de placas, cuando pudo explicarse de manera adecuada el movimiento de los continentes.
6. **TECTONICA DE PLACAS.-** Las corrientes de convección en el manto produce el movimiento de las placas litosféricas. Esta teoría explica fenómenos geológicos como el vulcanismo, la sismicidad y la formación de cordilleras.
7. **PANGUEA.-** Es el nombre del único continente que según la Teoría de la Deriva Continental, existía en la Tierra hace 200 millones de años.
8. **LAURASIA.-** Es la parte norte del Pangea.
9. **GONDWANA.-** Gondwana es el nombre que se le da a un antiguo bloque continental que resultó de la porción meridional de Pangea, cuando se extendió el mar de Tetis hacia el oeste. De Gondwana surgieron Sudamérica, África, Australia, el Indostán, la isla de Madagascar y la Antártida, a lo largo del Cretácico.
10. **CAMARA MAGMATICA.-** Es la región de la litosfera donde se acumula las soluciones magmáticas.
11. **CORTEZA.-** La corteza terrestre es la capa rocosa externa de la Tierra. Es comparativamente fina, con un espesor que varía de 7 km, en el fondo oceánico, hasta 70 km en las zonas montañosas de los continentes. Los elementos más abundantes de esta capa son el silicio, el oxígeno, el aluminio y el magnesio. La corteza de la Tierra ha sido generada por procesos ígneos, y estas cortezas son más ricas en elementos incompatibles que sus mantos subyacentes.
12. **CRATON.-** Un cratón o cratógeno es una masa continental llegada a tal estado de rigidez en un lejano pasado geológico que, desde entonces, no ha sufrido fragmentaciones o deformaciones, al no haber sido afectadas por los movimientos orogénicos. Por tal motivo los cratones tienden a ser llanos, o presentan relieves bajos con formas redondeadas y de rocas frecuentemente arcaicas. A los cratones submarinos se les llama mesocratones.
