And third, if one can talk of general standards governing conduct, how does one account for the diversity of moral systems and their change over time? The first is answered by showing that, like good taste in aesthetics, right taste in morals requires that the sentiments are educated; the second by arguing against the view that Hume is a subjectivist and a relativist; and the third, in chapter 6, by showing that his approach contains a view of progress left untouched by any personal prejudices Hume himself might harbor. The book concludes in chapter 7 by showing how Hume's view of philosophy affects the scope of any normative ethics.
