



argue that turquoise and copper mining and mining related productions were all local small scale and village based activities during the two periods The current evidence shows that early states did not place direct control over resource extraction and distribution in these peripheral regions Moreover based on the arguments and comparative cases in other regions of the world I further argue that the strategy of resource procurement of early states was never monopolistic Rather the Longshan and Erlitou period states adopted a decentralized strategy to procure key resources By considering Erlitou as a phenomenon of regeneration after Longshan collapses I argue that the center periphery relations maintained a strong continuity in this transitional period
