On the reflective side, Kierkegaard delves into a number of authors and religious figures, some of them for the first time, including Montaigne, Pascal, Seneca, Savonarola, Wesley, and F. W. Newman. These journals also contain Kierkegaard's thoughts on the decisions surrounding the publication of the *Anti-Climacus* writings, *The Sickness unto Death*, and especially *Practice in Christianity*. Kierkegaard's reader gets the sense both of a gathering storm by the close of the last journal in this volume, the famous attack on Christendom, is less than three years away, and a certain hesitancy. What needs reforming, Kierkegaard insists, is not the doctrine or the Church, but existences, i.e., lives.
