Salem the Berkshires then to The Wayside in Concord The Scarlet Letter was published in 1850 followed by a succession of other novels A political appointment as consul took Hawthorne and family to Europe before their return to Concord in 1860 Hawthorne died on May 19 1864 and was survived by his wife and their three children Much of Hawthorne's writing centers on New England many works featuring moral metaphors with an anti-Puritan inspiration His fiction works are considered part of the Romantic movement and more specifically dark romanticism His themes often center on the inherent evil and sin of humanity and his works often have moral messages and deep psychological complexity His published works include novels short stories and a biography of his college friend Franklin Pierce the 14th President of the United States In 1836 Hawthorne served as the editor of the American Magazine of Useful and Entertaining Knowledge

stands for Villa Montanto where the author made his home for a time in the summer of 1858 and the original of Hilda's tower is described in the French and Italian Note Books May 15 1858 This romance which is generally held to be somewhat inferior to the novels of American life though in an entirely different setting does not differ greatly from them or from some of the best short stories in the nature of its topic and the handling of its characters Like them it has for its theme a subject of conscience the influence of the consciousness of sin and its penalty in elevating the life of a soul Donatello's resemblance to the sculptured faun is typical of his spirit unawakened and looking neither before nor after until his crime puts an end forever to his joyous holiday existence and remorse for it develops his intellect and his soul Kenyon is a good type of a cultivated American quietly enthusiastic tolerant and not cynical loving art and not despising America Hilda is remarkable for the great moral strength united with her delicacy and sensibility Her suffering on account of the crime of which she has been merely a witness is strongly contrasted with the attitude of Miriam whose conscience needs to be brought to a full awakening even after participation in it her free and strong nature having been bewildered in a maze of wrong the one escape from which has offered itself in sudden temptation
