Jean Francois Lyotard

- *Metanarratives*

Lyotard views were unclear about what he thought of this movement. "Simplifying to the extreme, I define postmodern as incredulity (sceptical) toward metanarratives. The narrative function is losing its its great hero, its great dangers, its great voyages, its great goal.". This quote implies that he was unsure but other quotes suggests that he feels that we must address subjects within society to challenge views and values, with the use of metanarratives.

Fredric Jameson

- *Pastiche/Intertextuality*

Jameson's view is quite different and he encourages pastiche to convert the old to new and updated ideas. He believes that nothing is left to the imagination with today's journalists critiquing films before anyone else has had the chance to develop their OWN opinions. By making references to old and new films, you are creating a 'remix'



Jean Baudrillard

- *Hyperreality*

The idea that the line between reality and media is blurred, and people can not distinguish between the two. Baudrillard challenged this traditional convention, by making it clear that there was a difference.
