Compatibility Equations:

It is a fundamental problem of the theory of elasticity to determine the state of stress in a body submitted to the action of given forces. In a two-dimensional problem, it is necessary to solve the differential equations of equilibrium and the solution must be such as to satisfy the boundary conditions.

In 2D problems we consider three strain components namely,

$$\epsilon_x = \frac{\partial u}{\partial x}, \quad \epsilon_y = \frac{\partial v}{\partial y}, \quad \gamma_{xy} = \frac{\partial u}{\partial y} + \frac{\partial v}{\partial x} \quad \dots\dots\dots (a)$$
