with those acculturated art forms made by both Native Americans and Euroamericans that deliberately converge with and often appropriate each other's cultural properties. New concepts of technology in making art, new media, new subject matter, new styles, and new or different canons of aesthetics that were absent in a pre-contact situation for the Native and non-Native are now integrated into the visual and performing arts. By focusing on the acculturated arts, this exhibition will provide our multi-cultural community with a framework for better understanding and appreciating how these arts express fertile new ideas that are integrated into the matrix of tribe culture or society. A further objective is to question the accuracy and intentions of the Western artists, particularly from the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries, who appropriated cultural property from the different American Indian tribes, making visual constructions of them in alignment with the prevailing objectives of the dominant culture at that time. These arts can then be compared with the visual constructions made by contemporary North American Indian and non-Indian artists of the late twentieth century whose internationally recognized works address in avant-garde terms what it means to construct ethnic identities and cultural experiences that can and have led to misrepresentations of cultural truths and stereotypes. This exhibition is the effort of a group of enthusiastic undergraduates and graduates who took in the spring of 1996 my art history course on the arts and cultures of the Southwest, the Pueblo and Navajo/Diné peoples. Since Florida State University has identified with and valorized the achievements of the Florida Seminole Tribe, the group felt it fitting for FSU students to organize and develop a campus exhibition addressing aspects of past and present American Indian art and culture. Working under extraordinary time constraints and limited funding, these six undergraduates and eleven graduates never wavered in their commitment to this project. All of the students felt the need to see the arts and visit the cultural areas they were writing about.

First Look

Jersey City Museum, 2006. Founded as part of the Jersey City Public Library in 1901, the Jersey City Museum is the only cultural institution of its kind in the state. The museum's permanent collection features American art and material culture from the region dating from the colonial period through the present. This is the first collections catalog that the Museum has published and will introduce readers to its eclectic holdings. The selection of 150 objects presented chronologically represents highlights from each of the genres, including painting, sculpture, decorative arts, photography, works on paper, furniture, metals, and ephemera. The museum's own lengthy and varied history helped to form its collections. An essay by Alan Wallach, professor of American art at the College of William and Mary, addresses this history and the museum's role as a teaching institution. In addition to paintings and a small selection of sculpture, the museum houses a body of objects that relate to local history, including a collection of glass and ceramic works by the American Pottery Company and the Jersey Glass Company. Its industrial collection features advertisements and other ephemera produced by industries based in the area during the nineteenth century. The small but lovely collection of paintings includes a view of downtown New York from Brooklyn by Colin Campbell Cooper, a regal portrait of prominent Jersey City citizen Judge Peter Sip by the illustrious portrait

duo of Samuel Waldo and William Jewett and a 1986 painting by Helen Miranda Wilson of a bird's eye view of New York harbor The collection of contemporary art features imagery by a diverse body of significant artists including Chakaia Booker Larry Fink Leon Golub Komar and Melamid Conrad Marca Relli Sheila Pepe Naomi Savage Shazia Sikander and Kara Walker The Museum's recent history and its contemporary collection are addressed in an essay by the curator Rocio Aranda Alvarado **Essays on Women Artists** Liana Cheney, 2003 Art Now Gallery Guide, 1997 **48th Esposizione Internazionale D'arte** Harald Szeemann, Cecilia Liveriero Lavelli, 1999
