

# From tree to paper

The paper production process has remained basically the same since millenniums ago. However, nowadays, the technological advances allow its elaboration to be made in a mechanical way and in much greater scales than in ancient times. Eucalyptus (especially the *Eucalyptus globulus*) are some of the trees that are mostly used to manufacture paper.

## 1 GROWING

The nursery is started in the greenhouse and later transplanted to the ground.

**GREENHOUSE**  
It keeps the nursery at the appropriate temperature.

**PLANTING**  
Opens the furrows in the earth.



**HARVESTING**  
Branches and wood are eliminated, and the ground is harrowed.

**PLANTING**  
It is placed in furrows perpendicular to the direction of the wind, so it will not stop.

**DEFORESTATION**  
The development of the trees allows them after 10 years.

**DEFORESTATION**  
A defoliation machine cuts the trunk without damaging the tree.

## 1840

Wood from trees started being used in that decade to make paper. Before that, other plants were used.

## 2 DEFORESTATION

After 10 or 12 years, trees are cut. At the same time, replanting is done.

## 3 CLEANING

The bark is separated from the trunk, the trunk is washed and then cut in chips.

## 4 PASTE

Fibers are separated and put in water to purify and whiten them.

## 5 WHITENING

Whitening is achieved with chemical products, the suspended water.

## 6 LEAVES

The parts of paper arrive to a filtering machine that heats the fiber and lets the water to, going as a result, the leaves.

**DRYING**  
They have between 6 and 11% of water.

## 7 DRYING

Some cylinders heated with steam press the sheets and dry them.

## 8 ROLLING

Once the paper is dry, it goes called to large rolls to be transported according to its different uses.

## OTHER USES

Besides using it in the paper industry, eucalyptus leaves are used in the elaboration of perfumes and as an aromatic tea, while its flowers are a source of nectar and pollen for the bees in the honey industry.

## RECYCLING

40% of the paper and cardboard produced in Europe comes from recovered and recycled paper.
