

Small scale evaluations in school children in other countries:

Although numbers involved in individual studies are fairly small, all reveal a consistent pattern of increased signs of neuro-motor immaturity in children generally, with higher incidence in children who are under-achieving or receiving support for language, learning or behavioural problems.

Percentage of children in this category varies across regions and may or may not be related to socio-economic factors. Poverty is not necessarily the sole determinant, with children in more affluent areas sometimes showing similar signs. This may be the result of changes in early child caring practises including over-use of baby equipment, less time engaged in unrestricted physical play and social interaction, over exposure to electronic media and more sedentary lifestyles.

These are all areas for further investigation.
