How Shall Modern War be Conducted Justly?* Lilly Endowment Research Program in Christianity and Politics (United States),Paul Ramsey,1961 **War and the Christian Conscience How shall Modern War be Conducted Justly?** Paul Ramsey,2020-10-09 A fascinating inquiry into the ancient Christian theory of the just war and its application today In this volume a product of the Lilly Endowment Research Program a competent scholar deals with a major issue in the field of Christian ethics The central theme of the book is stated in the sub title How shall modern war be conducted justly The author seeks primarily to articulate principles of justice relevant to decisions concerning the nature and use of weapons by nations At this crucial period in international relations Dr Ramsey thinks that neither unlimited warfare nor the total abolition of force is the desirable solution of the tension He is convinced that statesmen should give attention to the kind of weapons that should be prohibited in what Dr Frank Graham has described as an era of mortal peril and immortal hope In the quest of a rationale for effective armament the author sets forth a revised version of the theory of the just war After a penetrating analysis of motifs in the doctrine of the just war in the writings of Augustine and Thomas Aquinas and in contemporary Roman Catholic and Protestant thought he presents norms by which right and wrong action in warfare may be distinguished He thinks that there is a basic moral difference between limited and total war and that the exposure of noncombatants including the children the sick and the aged to indiscriminate bombing can not be justified He is convinced that the possession or the use of megaton weapons surpasses reasonable and moral limitations of international conflict He believes that justice requires nations to settle disputes by diplomacy to explore every honorable way to avoid war and to prepare for a limited and purposeful defense He argues that counter forces warfare is the only kind of warfare that can be conducted justly and that present weapons of unlimited power should be eliminated at the earliest possible moment Olin T Binkley

**Conscience** Louisa Thomas,2011-06-02 Norman Thomas and his brothers upbringing prepared them for a life of service but their calls to conscience threatened to tear them apart Conscience is Louisa Thomas s beautifully written account of the remarkable Thomas brothers at the turn of the twentieth century At a time of trial each brother struggled to understand his obligation to his country family and faith Centered around the story of the eldest Norman Thomas later the six time Socialist candidate for president the book explores the difficult decisions the four brothers faced with the advent of World War I Sons of a Presbyterian minister and grandsons of missionaries they shared a rigorous moral upbringing a Princeton education and a faith in the era s spirit of hope Two became soldiers Ralph enlisted right away heeding President Woodrow Wilson s call to fight for freedom A captain in the Army Corps of Engineers he was ultimately wounded in France Arthur the youngest was less certain about the righteousness of the cause but sensitive to his obligation as a citizen and like so many men eager to have a chance to prove himself The other two were pacifists Evan became a conscientious objector protesting conscription

when the truce was signed on November 11 1918 he was in solitary confinement Norman left his ministry in the tenements of East Harlem New York and began down the course he would follow for the rest of his life fighting for civil liberties social justice and greater equality and against violence as a method of change Conscience reveals the tension among responsibilities beliefs and desires between ideas and actions and sometimes between brothers Conscience moves from the gothic buildings of Princeton to the tenements of New York City from the West Wing of the White House to the battlefields of France tracking how four young men navigated a period of great uncertainty and upheaval A Thomas family member herself Norman was Louisa s great grandfather Thomas proposes that there is something we might recover from the brothers debates about conscience a way of talking about personal liberty and social obligation about being true to oneself and to one another

placing the responsibility for alternative service on the shoulders of Hershey any program within Civilian Public Service the alternative service program for COs desired by the Historic Peace Churches Brethren Mennonite Society of Friends needed Hershey s approval before it could commence As a product of the National Guard Hershey possessed a strong belief in the duty of the citizen to the state in a time of national emergency However Hershey also had Mennonite ancestry and a strong belief in minority rights Though not personally religious all of his beliefs towards religion duty minority rights and service contributed to a much more liberal policy for COs during World War II compared to the insensitive treatment of them during the First World War In short Protector of Conscience Proponent of Service argues that Lewis Hershey held the primary authority for constructing policy concerning conscientious objection during World War II and his personal beliefs and actions in shaping alternative service during that time established precedent for the remaining years of conscription in the United States From the initial peacetime draft in 1940 to the end of conscription in 1973 alternative service remained as the central form of a CO s duty to the state in lieu of serving in the military Hershey s beliefs and actions during World War II resulted in a concept of alternative service that remained for the following years of conscription in the United States providing an illuminating example of how the concept of the citizen soldier evolved in American military history and extended even to those who refused to serve in the military
