ABSTRACT

Social capital is a topical concept in economic development. The claim is that regional differences in economic success can be explained in terms of differences in various social variables, called social capital. This paper attempts to delineate the mechanisms that link social capital and economic development. I show that social capital can produce two kinds of trust, both of which can reduce transaction costs. It is important to keep these two sources of trust apart, since development policies utilizing social capital have different impacts, depending on the basis of trust.

1. Social Capital and Economic Development

It has become increasingly popular to claim that regional differences in certain 'social variables' can explain regional differences in productivity and income. These seemingly non-economic variables, which capture various aspects of the social structure in a society, are often referred to as *social capital*. The claim is that social capital is important for economic development and progress. Many analysts convey great expectations to the concept of social capital. In a recent paper from the World Bank, social capital is called the 'missing link' in theories of economic development.¹ Another influential author on social capital, Robert Putnam, believes it will play a vital role in our understanding of economic development:
