Brownie Scouts were named Brownies by the man who started the Boy Scouts and Girl Guides in England. He is called the Father of Scouting. His name was Robert Baden-Powell. He knew many stories about "Brownies" or "Little People of Old England." Brownies would come into a home at night and help while the people were asleep. The founder thought Brownies would be a good name for girls who like to be useful as well as to play. He took the Brownie name from a story called *The Brownie*. You may read it in a book or hear it for yourself at a Troop meeting.

Imagination, magic and pretending were widely used in early Brownie programs. The programs were filled with useful home and nature-oriented activities to be taught by a Brown Owl with an imaginative, creative spirit. The "Whole Brownie Game" was made to help girls become alert, joyful, helpful and obedient through the quickening of their imagination through quaint ceremonies and elfin balls, fairy rings and road steel taran poles and stories! Names and symbols were taken from folklore. Patrols of SIXES could choose an Elf name and have an emblem of elf embroidered on their left uniform pockets to designate their group. In addition each Six had a song and a designated Six as the head.
