

have endeavoured not so much to give reviews of individual books and authors as to indicate what Mr Lanier took for the second part of his title but did not I think handle very satisfactorily in his text I may perhaps add without impropriety that the composition of this book has not been hurried and that I have taken all the pains I could by revision and addition as it proceeded to make it a complete survey of the Novel as it has come from the hands of all the more important novelists not now alive up to the end of the nineteenth century
