Rather than dismissing it as a mere academic problem, Schindler takes this contradiction as a key to understanding the strange paradoxes that abound in the contemporary values and institutions founded on the modern notion of liberty: the very mechanisms that intend to protect modern freedom render it empty and ineffectual. In this respect, modern liberty is diabolical, a word that means at its roots that which drives apart and so subverts. This is contrasted with the symbolical, a joining together which he suggests most basically characterizes the premodern sense of reality. This book will appeal to students and scholars of political philosophy, especially political theorists, philosophers in the continental or historical traditions, and cultural critics with a philosophical bent.

Grace and Freedom Richard A. His work was a major contribution to early modern Reformed thought, both in England and on the continent.
