Adams William James Henry James and Oliver Wendell Holmes Jr In 1860 Howells wrote Abraham Lincoln s campaign biography *Life Of Abraham Lincoln* and subsequently gained a consulship in Venice He married Elinor Mead on Christmas Eve 1862 at the American embassy in Paris She was a sister of sculptor Larkin Goldsmith Mead and architect William Rutherford Mead of the firm McKim Mead and White Among their children was architect John Mead Howells Editorship and other literary pursuits The Howells returned to America in 1865 and settled in Cambridge Massachusetts He wrote for various magazines including the *Atlantic Monthly* and *Harper s Magazine* In January 1866 James Fields offered him a position as assistant editor at the *Atlantic Monthly* he accepted after successfully negotiating for a higher salary though he was frustrated by Fields close supervision Howells was made editor in 1871 after five years as assistant editor and he remained in this position until 1881 In 1869 he met Mark Twain with whom he formed a longtime friendship But his relationship with journalist Jonathan Baxter Harrison was more important for the development of his literary style and his advocacy of Realism Harrison wrote a series of articles for the *Atlantic Monthly* during the 1870s on the lives of ordinary Americans Howells gave a series of twelve lectures on Italian Poets of Our Century for the Lowell Institute during its 1870 71 season He published his first novel *Their Wedding Journey* in 1872 but his literary reputation soared with the realist novel *A Modern Instance* 1882 which described the decay of a marriage His 1885 novel *The Rise of Silas Lapham* became his best known work describing the rise and fall of an American entrepreneur of the paint business His social views were also strongly represented in the novels *Annie Kilburn* 1888 *A Hazard of New Fortunes* 1890 and *An Imperative Duty* 1891
