


Steno's laws of stratigraphy

A. Original orientation




B. Orientation after tilting (folding)

Law of original horizontality


Layers of sedimentary rock are originally deposited flat.

Law of cross-cutting relationships
Rock layers A and B must be older than the intrusion (C) that disturbs them.
(Principle later reinforced by James Hutton.)

Law of lateral continuity

Layers of rock are continuous until they encounter other solid bodies that block their deposition or until they are acted upon by agents that appeared after deposition took place.
