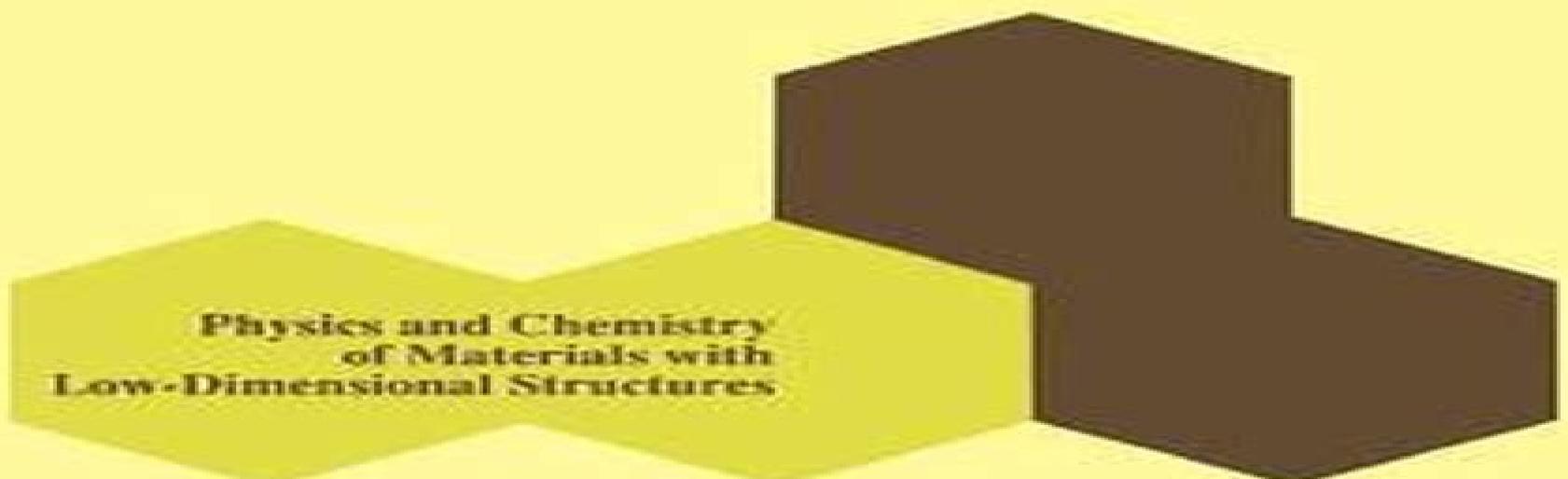

Villegas Rosales,2021 This thesis covers many body liquids and solids occurring in two dimensional electron systems 2DESs confined to GaAs and AlAs quantum wells subjected to a large perpendicular magnetic field and cooled to very low temperatures In GaAs 2DESs we systematically explored the fractional quantum Hall liquid energy gap Then the Wigner solid and fractional quantum Hall liquid competition was investigated in AlAs 2DESs Also the very low disorder GaAs 2DESs allow us to probe the thermal melting of bubble phases a type of Wigner solid In the first part of this thesis we report a systematic experimental study that incorporates very high quality 2DESs confined to GaAs quantum wells with fixed density and varying well widths The results demonstrate a clear decrease of the fractional quantum

Hall energy gap as the electron layer is made thicker and the short range component of the Coulomb interaction is weakened. We also provide a quantitative comparison between the measured energy gaps and the available theoretical calculations that take into account the role of finite layer thickness and Landau level mixing. All the measured energy gaps fall below calculated values but as the electron layer thickness increases experiments and calculations are in better agreement. Accounting for the role of disorder in a phenomenological manner we find better overall agreement between the measured and calculated energy gaps although some puzzling discrepancies remain. Next the fate of the ground state of a 2DES at very low Landau level filling factors ν where interaction reigns supreme was explored. We report experimental data for a new 2DES where the electrons are confined to an AlAs quantum well. The exceptionally high quality of the samples and the large electron effective mass allow us to determine the liquid solid phase diagram for the 2D electrons in a large range of filling factors near $\nu = 1/3$ and $\nu = 1/5$. The data and their comparison with an available theoretical phase diagram reveal the crucial role of Landau level mixing and finite electron layer thickness in determining the prevailing ground states. In the latter part of this thesis we present the screening properties of bubble phases probed via a simple capacitance technique where the 2DES is placed between a top and a bottom gate and the electric field penetrating through the 2DES is measured. The bubbles formed at very low temperatures screen the electric field poorly as they are pinned by the residual disorder potential allowing a large electric field to reach the top gate. As the temperature is increased the penetrating electric field decreases and surprisingly exhibits a pronounced minimum at a temperature that appears to coincide with the melting temperature of the bubble phase. We deduce a quantitative phase diagram for the transition from bubble to liquid phases for Landau level filling factors $4 < \nu < 5$.

Electron and hole systems confined in two dimensions exhibit a plethora of exotic quantum phases under perpendicular magnetic field at sufficiently low temperature. In this thesis we explore several of these quantum phases in state of the art high quality InAs and GaAs quantum wells and study their formation phase diagram and geometric resonance behavior under a one dimensional periodic magnetic modulation. The two dimensional 2D electron system in an InAs quantum well has emerged as a prime candidate for hosting exotic quasi particles with non abelian statistics such as Majorana fermions and parafermions. To attain its full promise however the electron system has to be clean enough to exhibit electron-electron interaction phenomena. In the first part of the thesis we present the observation of the fractional quantum Hall effect in a very low disorder InAs quantum well. At sufficiently low temperature and very high perpendicular magnetic field a deep minimum in the longitudinal resistance accompanied by a nearly quantized Hall plateau at Landau level filling factor $\nu = 4/3$.

was observed A sufficiently large perpendicular magnetic field quenches the kinetic Fermi energy of an interacting 2D system of fermions making them susceptible to the formation of a Wigner solid WS phase in which the charged carriers organize themselves in a periodic array to minimize their Coulomb repulsion energy In low disorder 2D electron systems confined to modulation doped GaAs heterostructures signatures of a magnetic field induced WS appear at low temperatures and very small Landau level filling factors $\nu \approx 1/5$ In dilute GaAs 2D hole systems on the other hand thanks to the larger hole effective mass and the ensuing Landau level mixing the WS forms at relatively higher fillings $\nu \approx 1/3$ In the second part of the thesis we present our measurements of the fundamental temperature vs filling phase diagram for the 2D holes WS liquid thermal melting Moreover via changing the 2D hole density we also probe their Landau level mixing vs filling WS liquid quantum melting phase diagram We find our data to be in good agreement with the results of very recent calculations although intriguing subtleties remain A high quality 2D electron system under a small perpendicular magnetic field exhibits ballistic cyclotron motion When the size of the cyclotron orbit is commensurate with an external one dimensional 1D density modulation a series of longitudinal resistance minima are observed as a result of this geometric resonance condition In a GaAs 2D electron system such 1D density modulation can be achieved through the piezoelectric effect along the 110 and $\bar{1}\bar{1}0$ crystallographic directions In the third part of this thesis we discuss a technique that imposes a 1D magnetic modulation to the GaAs 2D electron system in the 100 and 010 crystallographic directions where the piezoelectric effect is essentially zero This technique can be implemented to study the geometric resonance of other 2D systems such as the AlAs 2D electron system where the major axes of the carrier pockets are along the Γ directions By extending this technique to higher perpendicular magnetic fields one can also add an additional tool to probe the physics of the composite fermion systems
