model Model reveals a significant positive impact of banking sector on economic growth significant negative impact of non life insurance sector while stock market is not reported to have a significant impact An integrated model that controls for the impact of all key variables gives a strong support to the results obtained in models Results of models that attempt to control for the importance of regional disparities indicate that a significant positive relationship between life insurance and economic growth is reported for all regions but South Asia and North America Models that additionally control for differences in levels of development reveal a significant positive relationship between life insurance and economic growth in high middle and low income countries
