Astronomers discarded first hand visual observations because each observer measured a star's transit as occurring at a different time. Physicists soon followed them so that now instrumental measurements are the only data that physics and astronomy accept. The theory of evolution followed them in that physicalist mode by accounting only for the physical survival of organisms. That is why their sciences deny the existence of anything of a spiritual nature. This little book examines their theorized big bang beginning and the physicalist theory of evolution in the light of the newly measured human consciousness through whose thinking processes both of those sciences arose. Spiritual humanism aims to provide a nondogmatic faith in humanity and in principles which place human beings, their values, their thinking, and their enspirited consciousnesses as central to creating all of our sciences. The spiritual aspect arises especially from our consciousness which allows us to reflect upon what is in our awareness. The qualities of our awarenesses and consciousness are explained by the anthropomorphic theory of human perception which attributes human qualities even to our senses. The book suggests that consciousness places us in a realm of being beyond the physical. Though our physical brains are proposed as the basis for that consciousness, the outcome in consciousness creates a spiritual quality in human beings. Spiritual humanism accordingly is concerned with human beings and is centered entirely in this human world rather than in any other. Thus a non-dogmatic spiritual humanism for fostering the potentialities in human beings in this world is what this little book means to provide. The experiences of the young Helen Keller show how consciousness becomes the basis for disinterested interests, the ability to be deeply engrossed in something unrelated to our own self-interest. That disinterested interest is what lies behind our engagements with the arts, the sciences, and our religious aspirations. The assumption of an entirely physical origin for the physicists' theoretical big bang along with Darwin's physicalist theory of evolution are criticized because both methodologies preclude finding anything of the spirit. Eliot's wording² In the Netherlands the focus of the search for meaning today seems particularly centered on the immanent and in the interwoven human connectedness There is openness to a reality beyond the tangible and to testing the finality of this world's confines However transcendence will be found in the quotidian or not at all Yet even as religiosity and participation in spiritual practices has grown and the majority of people confess their belief in some divine presence or life source the impact in the Netherlands of this newfound spirituality on everyday life is not always evident Film as a window on the world even when it challenges the world it portrays provides us with fertile soil for our exploration of the saliency of today's spirituality The first chapter provides the preliminary study which establishes my thesis that the spiritual climate in the Netherlands today is best understood as Spiritual Humanism Skeptical voices question the depth of the contemporary surge in spiritual interest when it comes to its role in everyday life arguing that secularization is still the dominant paradigm through which to understand today's society This perspective I will argue is too narrow as it does not pay attention to the pervading spiritual dimension of life that is expressed in subtle non-religious ways Chapters II, III, and IV provide an in-depth analysis of the films of this investigation with a particular focus on the movies underlying spiritual vision

The shape of Spiritual Humanism emerges from these findings. The focus for this project has been on Gouden Kalf winning movies from 2000-2005. While studying the films individually it became evident that each shed light on the other either by affirming earlier positive findings or by enlarging and showing off wrong-headed directions in life. Discussing the films in pairs of two surfaced as the natural and most fruitful approach. Chapter V draws the contours of Spiritual Humanism in terms of four interconnected layers of spirituality. The implications of our findings for the theological dialogue and the place of the church in society are worked out in Chapter VI. This section centers on the biblical and theological vision of General Revelation in relationship to Special Revelation. The impact of contemporary science such as evolution and the developing understanding of human consciousness is part of this discussion. Guidance for this dialogue comes from among others Gerardus van der Leeuw's phenomenology of religion and Wolfhart Pannenberg's pneumatology.
