

Nature of Policy Problems

A policy problem is an unrealized need, value, or opportunity for improvement (Dunn, 2016). Public policy making is ultimately about solving, or at least attempting to solve, policy problems. That is easy to say, but much harder to do. One of the first barriers encountered when attempting to solve problems is being able to define problems in any meaningful way that can facilitate designing adequate solutions for those problems.

In order to describe what is going on, and to explain processes and outcomes in real-time processes, evaluators must pay more attention to problem definitions than usual. Defining a policy problem is an act of conceptualizing collective problems or challenges to be dealt with. It involves mobilizing others in a specific way to look at problems and solutions (Jennings, 1987; Spector and Kitsuse, 1987; Fischer, 1987, 1993; Schram, 1993; Hanberger, 1997). Hence, policy problems are socially or politically created. From an ontological point of view, there are no objective policy problems. Because there are no objective or scientific policy problems, evaluators need to pay more attention to prevailing definitions of the policy problem. In the public domain, all levels of government can mobilize and define policy problems. One way to deal with this situation is to turn the policy problem into an empirical question and unfold emerging and competing conceptions of the policy problem. Further, if a "wrong" definition of the problem is made it may mean that the ultimate "solution" for the problem will be delayed.

The main difference between issue and problem is that **issue is an important topic or problem for debate or discussion whereas problem is a harmful and unwelcome matter or situation that needs to be dealt with.**

Defining policy problems in a way that can be effective for policy design appears to be a two-step process: (1) Defining what the problem is (2) Develop a set of dimensions that can be used to characterize problems

Stage One: What is the Problem?

Is it a problem of agriculture, environment, or whatever. This can be a difficult question politically and even empirically, and it is often a crucial question for the resolution of the issue, and for the type of government response. Another confounded characteristic of defining the policy problem is that the most important problems themselves are becoming less clearly defined.
