

Next Steps

Observation notes are essential and vital to the EYF. The early years framework sets out a number of other priorities about next steps. Remember that you are writing a record for you for the child. Your records will help you see a different path from the children's story. The key next steps will provide all other than to support their child's learning and evidence their achievements. It also important to show how steps take the child. The following have help to the learning process and make them to be part of the progress.
