Ensuring these people have access to productive work and a better quality of life is the core development challenge of the first half of this century. Growth could itself be jeopardized over the longer term unless a transformation of society and the management of the environment are addressed integrally with economic growth. Now in its 25th edition, this year's World Development Report examines over a 50-year period the relationship between competing policy objectives of reducing poverty, maintaining growth, improving social cohesion, and protecting the environment.
