Wurtz's life and career in the politically complex period leading up to 1853. He then discusses the turning point in Wurtz's intellectual life, his conversion to the reformed chemistry of Laurent Gerhardt and Williamson, and his efforts, social and political as well as scientific, to persuade his colleagues of the advantages of the new system. He looks at political patronage or the lack thereof and at the insufficient material support from the French government during the middle decades of the century. The story offers insights into the changing status of science in this period and helps to explain the eventual course of both French and German chemistry.
